We will, however, waive the article processing charge for any article based on a session convener's recommendation, and all publication costs for such articles will be borne by PEPS.

We would like to apologize for asking you to undertake this additional work but we would be very grateful to receive your recommendations. It would be very helpful if you could give us at <peps_edit@jgqu.org> your answer, if possible, by the end of June.

This year we had the JpGU-AGU Joint Meeting 2017 successfully. Both unions will keep to have joint sessions in 2018 and after.
